REAR DRIVE CHAIN PRESSED CONNECTING LINK FOR SPORTSTER, ELECTRA GLIDE AND SERVI-CAR

All parts order 5/8 pitch rear drive chains, Part No. 40029-15A as used on the Sportster, Electra Glide and Servi-Car models are supplied with a press fit connecting link sideplate for improved chain durability.

This is the same type of chain as used for original equipment on new motorcycles shipped from the factory. Formerly all parts order chains were supplied with a slip fit connecting link under Part No. 40029-15.

A special chain press tool is available under Part No. 95020-66 (Price \$2.80 net) for easy installation of the chain sideplate. This tool is shown and described in Service Bulletin No. 533.

NOTE: If desired, the slip fit connecting link can still be ordered and used for emergency road repairs if desired. However, the press fit chain is recommended for use whenever possible.
